WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A REGULAR ROYAL ARCH PETITION AND A PETITION BY PROPOSAL

REGULAR PETITION

- 1. THE PETITION REQUIRES THE SIGNATURE OF TWO COMPANIONS FROM ANY RECOGNIZED ROYAL ARCH CHAPTER!
- 2. THE CANDIDATE SIGNS THE PETITION AND SUBMITS IT TO THE CHAPTER WHICH THEN VOTES TO ACCEPT OR REJECT IT!
- 3. IF THE CHAPTER VOTE IS FAVORABLE, THE CANDIDATE IS THEN SCHEDULED FOR THE DEGREES

PETITION BY PROPOSAL

- 1. THE PETITION REQUIRES THE SIGNATURE OF THREE COMPANIONS WHO BELONG TO THE CHAPTER IN VOTING ON PROPOSAL!
- 2. THE CHAPTER VOTES ON THE PETITION!
 IF THE VOTE IS FAVORABLE THE CHAPTER
 HP SIGNS A LETTER TO THE CANDIDATE
 STATING THAT HE HAS BEEN ACCEPTED
 BY THE CHAPTER TO RECEIVE THE ROYAL
 ARCH DEGREES. THIS LETTER SHOULD BE
 CONVEYED TO THE CANDIDATE BY ONE OR
 MORE OF THE PETITION PROPOSERS. THE
 CANDIDATE THEN ACCEPTS OR REJECTS IT.
- 3. IF THE PROPOSED CANDIDATE ACCEPTS IT, HE IS THEN SCHEDULED FOR THE DEGREES NO FURTHER CHAPTER VOTE IS REQUIRED.
